Elevating Roof Canvas Repair Kit

CONTENTS:

2 x 75 mm circular instant repair patches

2 x 150 x 30 mm instant repair patches

2 x 150 x 30 canvas patches

2 x tubes of canvas polyurethane repair glue

2 x alcohol cleaning wipes

1 x 100 x 100 mm square flyscreen repair patch

1 x glue spatula

INSTRUCTIONS

The canvas should be clean and 100% dry before application. Alcohol wipes can be used for cleaning.

Patches: These can be used on their own for an instant, semi-permanent fix. When applying a patch, support the canvas from the other side using a flat surface so the patch can be rubbed with a finger nail or other non-sharp object, ensuring smooth and even application. They can be used outside the canvas but can get moisture behind them and will last longer on the inside of the canvas where possible. It is sometimes possible to pull the damage together by sticking the patch to one side and using the patch to pull the canvas/flyscreen together.

Glue: This can be used on its own for a near-invisible repair. If using a patch to hold the material together with enough time for the glue to dry on the inside (the patch can then be left or removed after the glue is cured). Or if using the glue on the outside with tape inside, the patch can be left a permanent repair.

Be aware that the glue can take up to 12 hours to fully cure especially in cooler weather.

Always ensure the glue is fully cured before closing the roof.
